

City Bridge Trust awards Merton CIL £247,000 to tackle poverty, inequality and increase independence with local Deaf & Disabled People.

Over the next 5 years, City Bridge Trust – the City of London Corporation’s charity funder – will help Merton CIL to increase independence and inclusion for the local Deaf and Disabled community in Merton after awarding the organisation £247,300 to continue delivering and developing an accredited, person centred and accessible home visiting advice and advocacy service.

Stark health inequalities during the pandemic brought to the forefront, an increased need for specialist advice around health and healthcare. In 2019, we conducted in-depth research into the housing needs of local Deaf and Disabled people, we found that there is a clear need for disability specific housing advice. The generous grant from City Bridge Trust enables us to provide much needed health support from April 2021 and to work towards re-opening our housing advice service in late 2021.
